This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus for the issuance of directions to respondent no.7 i.e. school to provide the necessary or required documents of the students as less than 7 days are left with the petitioners to get the names of their children registered for next sessions as the last date for registration of exams is 18.9.2023.
