Petitioner seeks regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.153 dated 12.05.2022 registered under Section 21(C)/27-A/29 of NDPS Act and under Section 201 IPC at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

Allegations are that 505 grams of heroin i.e. commercial category of contraband was recovered from co-accused Mohan Lal. It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that initially said co-accused Mohan Lal suffered statement implicating one Nigerian person from whom he had purchased the contraband. However, later on in other disclosure statement, he named the petitioner and one more person, who had supplied the contraband.

Concededly, no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 23.06.2022. Trial may take time to conclude.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and having regard to the factual position as above, this bail petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted to bail on his furnishing personal bail bonds

and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/ learned
Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
