1. Challenge in the instant petition is to order Annexure P/1 dated 17.09.2019, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Faridabad/Executing Court dismissing the application filed by the petitioner/judgment debtor seeking permission to pay the respondents/decreed holder the amount along with compensation as per collector rate for the strip of land measuring 8x10.5 feet total 85 sq. yards, to the extent the same falls under his occupation, upon which house of the petitioner is situated and for allowing the application of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel contends that notice was issued in the instant case on the ground that he did not challenge the impugned order on merits but prayed that the matter be decided through mediation as he was ready to pay the collector rate/market rate.

3.           Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1 states that the application filed by the petitioner to the above effect has already been dismissed by the learned Executing Court and the offer of the petitioner is not acceptable.
4.           In view of the position noted above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the instant petition.
5.           Accordingly, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed.
