This is a civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents to provide access code/password to enable the petitioner to appear at the LLB 6th Semester examination to be held on 19.10.2022; 21.10.2022; 26.10.2022 and 28.10.2022.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that the dates of the said examination have already crossed and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
