DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner was convicted under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Appeal against conviction was admitted on 05.01.2023. However, petitioner was directed to deposit 20% of the compensation amount within a period of 30 days vide order dated 06.03.2023 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Appellate Court. Petitioner failed to make compliance of the said order and even did not appear before the Court on 29.05.2023 due to which his bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest were directed to be issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner request for one more opportunity to the petitioner so as to surrender before the Appellate Court, submitting that petitioner is ready to make compliance of the order dated 06.03.2023.

This petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra on or before 07.10.2023 to make compliance of the order dated 06.03.2023 (Annexure P-5).

If by that time, petitioner make compliance, he shall be admitted to fresh bail by the Appellate Court.

It is made clear that in case of non-compliance of any of the directions, the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed without any further direction.
