The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.90 dated 12.07.2017, registered under Sections 307, 365, 368, 323, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC (offence under Sections 307, 120-B of IPC added later on) and Section 25, 27 of Arms Act. 1959 at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, District Police Commissioner, Jalandhar (P-1) on the basis of compromise dated 08.09.2022 (P-2)

Pursuant to order dated 18.11.2022, report dated 14.02.2023 has been received from Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.90 dated 12.07.2017, registered under Sections 307, 365, 368, 323, 506, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC (offence under Section 307, 120-B

of IPC added lateron) and Section 25, 27 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar, District Police Commissioner, Jalandhar (P-1) alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioners.
