By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.219 dated 01.06.2022 registered at Police Station Agroha, District Hisar, under Sections 363, 366-A read with Section 34 IPC (wherein the offence under Section 506 is stated to have been added later-on).

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Jagdish Ram from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order as passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 29.11.2022, the petitioners have joined in the investigation and their

custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, they are also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioners named Satish Kumar and Vinod Kumar by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 29.11.2022, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioners shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
