1. This appeal has been filed by the appellant-wife challenging judgement and decree dated 20.02.2018 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Patiala whereby her petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act seeking dissolution of her marriage with the respondent has been dismissed.
