The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.153 dated 07.08.2022 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (to which Section 29 of the NDPS Act was added later on) at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of order dated 09.11.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.11.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
