Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.292 dated 7.7.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC (Sections 325, 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station Chandhat, District Palwal.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed and the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioner who was stated to be armed with wooden *danda* at the time of the occurrence. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order of interim bail.

State counsel on instructions from SI Padam Singh submits that

the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and got effected recovery of the *danda* used by him in the commission of the crime and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 10.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
