1. This is a Criminal Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner and another prayer has also been made for proper investigation in FIR No.88 dated 14.08.2023 registered under Sections 353, 186, 120-B, 506 and 295 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 332 of IPC has been added later on) at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Batala.

2. Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported as 2008(2) SCC 409** and in **M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011, decided on 20.03.2020**, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue alternative remedies in accordance with law.

3. In view of the above, the present Criminal Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
