1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents no.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.
2. Upon instructions from ASI Kamaljit Singh, State counsel submits that in deference to order dated 15.09.2023 passed by this Court, statement of petitioner No.2 has been recorded, who has stated that she has no longer perceives any threat from the private respondents. Copy of the statement of petitioner No.2 has been placed on the record.
3. In view of the above development, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
