1. On 05.10.2023, following order was passed:-

“Challenge is to the order dated 11.08.2023, whereby the bail of the petitioner stands cancelled and the bail bonds stand forfeited.

The petitioner who was booked in FIR No.102 dated 20.04.2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 21(b) and 27-A of the NDPS Act, was absent which led to the passing of the impugned order. The reason submitted is that the petitioner was in custody in some other case.

Notice of motion for **20.11.2023**.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on or before **18.10.2023**.

In the meantime, the operation of the impugned order dated 11.08.2023 shall be kept in abeyance.”

2. Counsel for the petitioner has produced order dated 09.10.2023 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad to demonstrate that the petitioner in compliance of the orders passed by this Court appeared before the concerned Court.

3. Reply by way of affidavit of Virender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ratia, District Fatehabad on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed. The same is taken on record. The aforesaid fact as stated by counsel representing the petitioner also stands affirmed by the contents as contained in para 12 of the preliminary submissions of the aforesaid reply.

3. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner undertakes to regularly appear before the trial Court.

4. In view of above, the present petition is disposed off. Since the petitioner has already caused appearance before the concerned Court, order dated 11.08.2023 (P-10) is hereby quashed.

5. Ordered accordingly.
