JASJIT SINGH BEDI.J (Oral)

The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 407 Cr.P.C read with Section 482 Cr.P.C is for transfer and clubbing the trials arising out of FIR No.44 dated 29.2.2020 registered under Sections 411/34 IPC at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar pending before the JMIC, Amritsar to the court of Additional Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, where the trial of the same occurrence is pending arising out of case FIR No.66 dated 25.2.2020 under sections 379-B, 342, 459, 506, 34 IPC (offence under section 379-B, 34 IPC stands deleted and offence under section 395, 460, 325, 411, 201 added later on), Police Station, City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that he wishes to withdraw the present petition as regards clubbing of the aforesaid cases.

The prayer is allowed.

Ordered accordingly.

As regards the prayer for transfer of aforesaid cases, the counsel contends that initially No.66 dated 25.2.2020 under sections 379-B, 342, 459, 506, 34 IPC (offence under section 379-B, 34 IPC stands deleted and offence under section 395, 460, 325, 411, 201 added later on), Police Station, City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran was registered with the allegations that robbery of Rs.1.75 crores had been committed within the jurisdiction of Police Station, Tarn Taran. Thereafter the proceeds were recovered leading to registration of FIR No.44 dated 29.2.2020 registered under Sections 411/34 IPC at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar. He, therefore, contends that case FIR No.44 dated 29.2.2020 registered under Sections 411/34 IPC at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar, be transferred from Amritsar to District Tarn Taran.

The said prayer is not opposed by the learned Amicus Curiae as also the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the Sessions Judge, Amritsar is directed to transfer the case file of FIR No.44 dated 29.2.2020 registered under Sections 411/34 IPC at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar to the court of competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran.

Disposed of.
