ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the impugned FIR No.256, dated 26.09.2022, registered at Police Station Division A, Amritsar, under Sections 420, 34 IPC.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case he may be permitted to raise all his points, which have been raised in the present petition, at the time of framing of charges before the trial Court provided that the concerned trial Court answers all the arguments raised by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law.

The prayer is innocuous because framing of charges cannot be an empty formality but an application of mind by the trial Court.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all his points raised before this Court, before the trial Court at the time of framing of charges, the concerned Court shall advert to all his points. Further liberty is reserved to the petitioner to challenge the order of framing charges, if so passed by the trial Court.
