Application is disposed of accordingly.

FAO-M-344 of 2018.

This appeal has been filed by the appellant-wife, challenging judgment and decree dated 01.10.2018, passed by the learned District Judge, Kapurthala, whereby petition filed by her under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act (for short 'the Act'), seeking dissolution of marriage between parties, has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that during pendency of this appeal, matter has been amicably resolved between the parties, who have decided to part ways. Respondent-husband, it is submitted has no objection if the present appeal is allowed. He is now stated to be residing in Greece. Affidavit dated 09.01.2023 of the respondent has been filed. It is specifically stated that the respondent has no objection if the present appeal is allowed and that as per the settlement, appellant would withdraw her

application under Section 24 of the Act and would not claim maintenance in future from him.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he is duly authorized by the respondent-husband to state on his behalf that respondent indeed has no objection, in case, petition under Section 13 of the Act, filed by the appellant-wife, is allowed and decree of divorce granted.

Statement of appellant-wife has been recorded separately to the effect that she will not stake any claim past, present and future including permanent alimony, maintenance etc., qua her husband-Satinder Kumar. It is agreed that she will not file any case, civil or criminal against respondent-Satinder Kumar/his family members or initiate any proceedings in relation to their matrimony and any proceedings, if initiated by her, shall be withdrawn. She seeks to withdraw her application under Section 24 of the Act as well. Ordered accordingly.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, judgment and decree dated 01.10.2018, passed by the learned District Judge, Kapurthala, is set aside. Marriage solemnized between the parties on 14.07.1999 is hereby dissolved. Parties shall remain bound by their statement/affidavit. Appeal is disposed of accordingly. Decree sheet be prepared accordingly.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
