Learned counsel for the parties conjointly submits that in view of the order dated 25.09.2023, passed by the Supreme Court in Civil Appeal No.5982 of 2023 (**State Environment Impact Assessment Authority & Ors v. RSA Motors Pvt. Ltd.**) and Civil Appeal No.6111 of 2023, the respondent authorities had already de-sealed the premises and restored the electricity supply.
