The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.245 dated 14.08.2023 registered under Sections 21-C (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing, Jalandhar Range, Jalandhar.

A short reply dated 03.10.2023 by way of an affidavit of Yogesh Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Task Force, Jalandhar Range has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.09.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 15.09.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
