This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari
quashing the order dated 29.07.2022 (Annexure P-3) passed by the
Superintending Canal Officer, Sirhind Canal Circle, Ludhiana-respondent
no.1 and order dated 08.11.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Divisional
Canal Officer, Bathinda Canal Division, Bathinda-respondent no.2

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sunil Kumar,
Zileadar, Bathinda Canal Division, Bathinda, has submitted that the
compromise has been effected between the parties and the present petition
has been rendered infructuous.
