This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.263 dated 04.10.2022 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Division A, Amritsar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contented and satisfied in case he may be permitted to raise all the pleas, which have been raised in the present petition, at the time of framing of charges before the trial Court provided that the concerned trial Court considers all the arguments raised by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to raise all pleas before the trial Court, as have been raised before this Court at an appropriate stage. This Court is sanguine that the trial Court shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law.
