1. The applicants/appellants have filed application bearing
No.CM-8197-C-2023 under Section 151 CPC for allowing the regular
second appeal in view of the terms and conditions of the compromise dated
20.07.2023 (Annexure A/1) arrived at between the parties. A photocopy of

the compromise has been attached with the application, however, original copy of the compromise has been produced in the Court which is place on record as Mark ‘A’.

2. Respondent No.1(iii)-Gagandeep Singh, who is present in the Court, has signed the compromise in the Court in the presence of the parties.

3. In terms of compromise (Annexure A/1) a demand draft No.739575 dated 24.07.2023 amounting to Rs.12,00,000/- and a cheque bearing No.106018 dated 25.07.2023 amounting to Rs.1,00,000/- have been handed over by the appellants to the respondents. Photocopy of the same has been produced in the Court which is also taken on record.

4. The parties, who have been identified by their respective counsel, have also suffered a statement in the Court that they have compromised the matter and the instant regular second appeal may be disposed of in terms of the compromise dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure A/1).

5. Consequently, the present regular second appeal is disposed of in view of compromise dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure A/1) arrived at between the parties. Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the compromise.

6. Misc. Application(s) pending, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
