Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.325 dated 30.10.2017, registered under Sections 302, 34 (Sections 212 & 120-B added subsequently) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, '*the IPC*'); Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station, A Division, District Amritsar, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, confines his prayer that the learned trial Court be directed to expedite the proceedings.

3. Although, this Court is not inclined to issue any mandate in the matter, but considering the fact that FIR was registered way back on 30.10.2017, learned trial Court is requested to proceed expeditiously without granting any unwarranted adjournments to either of the parties.
