SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.(ORAL)

1. Since the writ relief, is intimated to this Court by learned State counsel, upon instructions given to him by Mr. Jaminderjit Singh, Panchayat Officer, to become mitigated, inasmuch as, a petition under Section 3, 4, 5, and, 7 of the Punjab Public Premises Eviction (Rent and Recovery) Act, 1959, hence becoming instituted before the learned Collector concerned.

2. Therefore, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the instant writ petition.

3. Leave granted.

4. Consequently, the extant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the learned Collector concerned, shall permit the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned, to step into the witness box, to

render evidence in respect of the petition claim. Moreover, the progress of the petition (supra), as, instituted before the learned Collector concerned, shall be closely, and, regularly monitored by the learned Collector of the revenue district concerned. The decision, on the petition (supra), be ensured to be made positively within a period of six months' from today, but, after assigning an opportunity of hearing to all affected concerned.
