Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents to take action on the representation submitted by the petitioners and to incorporate the sale deed/conveyance deed in favour of the petitioners within a time bound frame.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has fairly submitted that though the grievance of the petitioners regarding the sale deed/conveyance deed, has already been redressed but thereafter, mutation regarding the same has not been entered by the respondent-authorities. He has submitted that the petitioners would file appropriate petition/application for entering the mutation and the respondent-authorities be directed to take necessary legal action on the same.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the grievance of the petitioners as prayed for, has already been redressed, thus, qua the same, the present petition is rendered infructuous. However, if the petitioners file appropriate application/petition regarding entering the mutation, the respondent-authority would take action on the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
