The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0125 dated 03.07.2023 registered under Sections 61/1/14 of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Samana, District Patiala, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.09.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 30.11.2023 by way of an affidavit of Neha Aggarwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Samana, District Patiala has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. She on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 25.04.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
