RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

This petition has been filed by the petitioner Institute assailing the communication dated 11.09.2023 (P-23), whereby the Indian Nursing Council (INC) has stated that the petitioner Institute would be inspected for the next academic year in accordance with the Indian Nursing Council (Minimum pre-requisites for granting suitability to Nursing Programs) Regulations, 2020.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has complied with the deficiencies, as pointed out by the team of the INC, and has also submitted compliance report before the authorities, but no inspection has been conducted. He fairly submits that the petitioner Institute has directly approached this Court challenging the

communication (*ibid*) without filing representation before the authorities and, in such circumstances, the petitioner may be permitted to approach the concerned authorities by filing a representation.

Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, submits that in case the petitioner does so, the authorities concerned shall look into the representation to be filed by the petitioner and do the needful in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.

Taking the aforesaid statements of learned counsel for the parties on record and in terms thereof, the petition is disposed of.
