HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents be directed to change the cadre of the petitioner from the post of Sweeper to the post of Motor Cleaner, which is lying vacant.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the petitioner, who is working as Sweeper, wants to change his cadre from the post of Sweeper to the post of Motor Cleaner, which is lying vacant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said benefit of change of cadre has already been given to the number of other employees whose cadre have been changed upon their representation, hence, the respondents are under obligation to grant the petitioner the benefit of change of cadre from Sweeper to Motor Cleaner keeping in view the fact

that the petitioner is fully eligible for the grant of said benefit.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the redressal of the grievance as raised in the present petition, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Notice of motion.

6 Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

7. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, the representation dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the respondents within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
