The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the impugned order dated 30.8.2022 (Annexure P-4) whereby non-bailable warrants of the petitioner were issued for 26.09.2022 in DDR No.18 dated 03.08.218 under Sections 452 , 323, 148 and 149 IPCat Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur in case FIR No.24 dated 02.03.2018 under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur (Section 302 IPC added later on).

On 21.10.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside the impugned order dated 30.8.2022 (Annexure P-4) whereby non-bailable warrants of the petitioner were issued for 26.09.2022 in DDR No.18 dated 03.08.218 under Sections 452 , 323, 148 and 149 IPCat Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur in case FIR No.24 dated 02.03.2018 under Sections 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police

Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur (Section 302 IPC added later on).

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was unable to appear on one date i.e. 30.08.222 because of which the impugned order (Annexure P-4) has been passed. He contends that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 27.02.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.10,000/- as costs with the Sadhna Society for the Mentally Handicapped, Near Housing Board Chowk, Raen Basera Building, Manimajra, Sector 13, Chandigarh and on his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of learned trial Court.”

In pursuance to the said order, the petitioner has appeared and deposited a sum of Rs.10,000/- as is apparent from the order dated 28.10.2022 passed by the Sessions Judge, Ferozepur. The copy of the said order is marked as X and Y.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
