1 This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No.55 dated 07.07.2015 under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 12.09.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been acquitted by the learned trial Court in terms of judgment dated 19.02.2023 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar. Moreover, the appeal preferred against the said judgment has also been dismissed on 25.09.2023 by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar.

3. Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petition be dismissed having been rendered infructuous.
