**CM-2575-CWP-2023 IN/& CWP-25994-2022**

This is an application under Section 151 CPC read with Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to pursue CWP-2843-2023 which has been filed challenging the order dated 20.01.2023 which has been passed, during the pendency of the present writ petition.

Learned senior counsel for the applicant-petitioner has submitted that the main petition in which prayer for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to issue formal acknowledgment of the deemed occupation certificate in the terms of statutory form submitted by the petitioner on 08.08.2021, be preponed from 22.03.2023 to today as he seeks to withdraw the main petition with liberty to pursue CWP-2843-2023.

Learned State counsel has submitted that she has no objection in case the main petition is preponed from 22.03.2023 to today.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the application is allowed and the main petition is preponed from 22.03.2023 to today and the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue CWP-2843-2023.

The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
