N.S. SHEKHAWAT, J.

1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and also direct to respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in their lives and liberty.

2. Petitioners, who are present in Court, submit that they have already submitted a representation dated 13.09.2023 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala and the petitioners shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into their representation dated 13.09.2023 (Annexure P-5).

3. The Bar has abstained from work.

4. From the perusal of the case file, it is apparent that there is only a limited prayer on behalf of the petitioners that their their life and liberty

may be protected at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and they have already submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) in this regard.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioners and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Ambala, is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate orders, in accordance with law.

6. This order shall not be construed as an expression/opinion on the validity of the marriage of the petitioners. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take to appropriate law, if any.

7. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
