The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.602 dated 05.10.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station City Sonapat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 18.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Virender Singh, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police City, Sonipat has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 08.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
