The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to decide the Complaint/Representation dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for respondent No.1- Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh submits that the present petition has already become infructuous since the aforesaid complaint/representation dated 25.02.2022 (Annexure P-6) has already been decided and dismissed by the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana. As such, the petitioners would have their own remedies in accordance with law.

However, in view of the above statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1-Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, Chandigarh, the present petition is hereby disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
