Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner arising out of FIR No. 11 dated 31.01.2021 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 66 (D) I.T. Act, 2000, registered at Police Station Gidderhaba, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1).

2. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the FIR in question was registered against the petitioner, at the instance of respondent No. 4, and the petitioner has moved a representation dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) for conducting fair and just inquiry in the matter. But no action till date has been taken thereon.

5. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Swati Batra, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

After hearing the respective submissions; considering the averments made in the petition and without commenting on the merits thereon, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mini Secretariat, Sri Muktsar Sahib, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) and dispose of the same in an expeditious manner under the provisions of the law.
7. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
