1. Prayer in this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to enquire into the complaint of the petitioner and further to take appropriate action against respondent No.4 as well as to get recovered the car of the petitioner from the said respondent.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to approach the jurisdictional Magistrate under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C., in the light of the ratio in *Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others*, (2008) 2 SCC 409 and *M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another*, (2020) 16 SCC 728.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
