Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned
order dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-8) and order dated 21.05.2018
(Annexure P-6), passed by respondents No.1 and 2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.3 at the outset submits that he has no objection if the impugned orders are set aside and the case is remanded back for decision afresh.

In view of the same, the present petition stands allowed. Impugned orders dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-8) and 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-6) are set aside and the case is remanded to respondent No.2- Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Nakodar, Jalandhar, who will decide the case afresh in accordance with law expeditiously preferably within a period of three months from today.
