1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 29.05.2023 passed in CWP-20595-2022.
2. Short reply dated 12.12.2023 by way of affidavit of Gaurav Yadav, IPS, Director General of Police, Punjab, has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the State, after going through the short reply, has submitted that the order dated 29.05.2023 has since been complied with, and accordingly, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
