1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No. 5 to 10.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already submitted a representation (Annexure P-6) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Police Headquarters, Sector 9, U.T., Chandigarh and he shall be satisfied in case, the appropriate directions are issued to the SSP Chandigarh-respondent No. 2 to look into the matter and to take appropriate action, in accordance with law.

3. Notice of motion qua respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

4. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Virenjeet Singh Mahal, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to depute a senior police officer to look into the matter and after getting the report from the senior police officer, the respondent No. 2 shall pass appropriate orders on the representation (Annexure P-6), submitted by the petitioner, expeditiously, in accordance with law.
