The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0033 dated 08.02.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324 341 506 IPC (Sections 326, 148 and 149 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sudhir Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
