The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0033 dated 08.02.2022 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, IPC (Sections 326, 148 and 149 IPC added later on) at Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.11.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sadhu Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 22.11.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 22.11.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
