VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-school to waive off the annual fee of daughter of the petitioner for the academic session 2020-21, with a further prayer to allow the daughter of the petitioner to attend online classes for the academic session 2021-22 for Class KG.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the respondents are *ad idem* that in the present case, the only issue that survives is with respect to the waiving off of the annual fee during Covid period i.e., July 2020 to March, 2021 as the daughter of the petitioner has already been permitted to join online classes and for the

said relief, the appropriate authority is the Fee and Fund Regulatory Committee.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view the above, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the Fee and Fund Regulatory Committee for the subsisting grievance.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents have submitted that they have no objection to the said course of action.

5. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Fee and Fund Regulatory Committee in accordance with law.
