In compliance of the order dated 24.01.2023, reply by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Rewari has been filed in the Court today.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of aforesaid affidavit, submits that in pursuance of the order dated 15.03.2023, DSP, City Rewari submitted a fact finding report that SI Ran Sing, then SHO, Police Station Rampura filed an affidavit dated 30.03.2022 in this Court that MLRs are not available, though the same were part of the petition. It is further submitted that a show cause notice was issued to SI Ran Singh and he has been awarded punishment of stoppage of two annual increments without cumulative effect and FIR No.96 dated 20.04.2023 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC stands registered at Police Station Rampura, on the complaint of petitioner No.3 Tushar and the investigation is going on.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.

Liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so required.
