AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, 'the Act') for appointment of an arbitrator for adjudication of disputes between the parties.

The petitioner was allotted work for construction of EWS quarters. Clause 24 of the general terms and conditions provides for dispute resolution through arbitration.

There was a dispute between the parties.

The petitioner served notice dated 27.7.2021 for appointment of arbitrator. The needful having not been done, the present petition was filed.

Reply filed on behalf of respondent No. 2 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the parties agree to the appointment of Mr. Ashok Kumar Singla, District & Sessions Judge (Retd.).

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of by appointing Mr. Ashok Kumar Singla, District & Sessions Judge (Retd.), H. No. 486, Punjab IAS /PCS Colony, Mullanpur, New Chandigarh as sole arbitrator.

The arbitrator shall be paid fee in accordance with the Fourth

Schedule of the Act, as amended. The fee of the arbitrator will be equally borne by both the parties.

The arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings as per time limit specified under Section 29A of the Act.

It is clarified that the reference shall be subject to the petitioner's complying with all the requirements of the agreement including the condition of pre-deposit.

Since the main case has been disposed of, pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.

Copy of the order be sent to the appointed arbitrator.
