At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the impugned order dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-9) inquiry proceedings are stated to have been initiated against the petitioner. Thus he limits the prayer in the present writ petition that the same be ordered to be conducted in a time bound manner.

Mr. Kunal Sharma, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of the respondents and on instructions from Mr. Deepak Kumri, Addl. S.E., PSPCL, Fazilka (Punjab) submits that the departmental proceedings initiated against the petitioner vide chargesheet dated 06.06.2022 as reflected in the impugned order (Annexure P-9) shall be concluded within a period of 3 months.

Finding it to be a fair request, present writ petition is disposed off with a direction to respondents No.1 & 2 to conclude the proceedings against the petitioner initiated vide charge-sheet issued vide office order No.77 dated 06.06.2022 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Disposed off accordingly.
