1. Bar Association has resolved to suspend work due to unfortunate demise of its former President, Shri S.D.Sharma, Senior Advocate, as a mark of respect.

2. Petitioners No.1 and 2 have filed self attested xerox copy of their Aadhar Cards, which are taken on record.

3. Renu Bala and Pawan Kumar, petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be of marriageable age. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8. They apprehend danger from them and seek protection to their life and liberty. They have placed on record Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-3, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 14.09.2023, Annexure P-4, to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, District Fazilka – respondent

4. Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-4, and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.
