DEEPAK GUPTA, J.(Oral)

As per the custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 1 year, 4 months and 13 days. He is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.0342, dated 09.08.2018, registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, under Sections 382, 427/34 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, the trial of which is pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Barnala.

Bail petition is opposed by learned State counsel on the ground that petitioner was once allowed bail but he absented for three dates due to which his bail has been cancelled.

The offence is triable by the Magistrate. Petitioner is in custody for the last more than 1 year and 4 months. Trial may take time to conclude. No purpose shall be served by keeping him detained. Petitioner is admitted to bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
