Main case

In essence, the petitioner prays for the direction to the respondent to compassionately appoint him in place of his father late Sh. Nathu Ram, who died on 31.05.1983. The claim of the petitioner has been rejected by a detailed order passed on 17.11.2021. The petitioner on attaining the age of majority for the first time lodged his claim seeking appointment in the year 2001. The claim of the petitioner is stale. The entire purpose of granting compassionate appointment is to help the family of the deceased in the situation of immediate difficulty, which the family of the employee dying in harness faces due to the unexpected demise of the breadwinner of the family.

After a period of 40 years, it would not be appropriate to issue any direction in this regard.

Dismissed.
