The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.48 dated 18.01.2022 registered under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 406 of the IPC was deleted and Section 379 of the IPC was added later on) at Police Station Sadar Gohana, District Sonipat.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Anil Kumar, submits that in pursuance of order dated 21.10.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.10.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
