For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the copy of air ticket of the petitioner is taken on record as Annexure P-15 subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-53732-2021 (O&M)

The petitioner is challenging the order dated 05.11.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Jalandhar vide which she was declared a proclaimed offender in case FIR No.24 dated 25.02.2015 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Division No.1, District Jalandhar.

In compliance of order dated 19.01.2023, photocopy of the air ticket of the petitioner has been placed on record qua her intended

travel to India. As per the air tickets, the petitioner is due to land in Delhi on 24.03.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was unaware about the registration of the FIR in question, however, as soon as she learnt about the registration of the FIR in question, she has compromised the matter with respondents No.2 and 3.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear and surrender before the Trial Court soon after landing in India. A prayer has, therefore, been made that in the aforementioned facts and circumstances, the petitioner be protected till her appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that her bail application which she would be filing on her surrender, be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 and 3 does not dispute the factum of the compromise having indeed been effected between the parties.

I have heard learned counsel and perused the material on record.

In view of the submissions made and undertaking given by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear and surrender before the Trial Court on or before 31.03.2023. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioner.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within the above stipulated time, this order shall be of no avail to her. In case, on appearance and surrender, the

petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
