ANIL KSHETARPAL, J

1. This is the petitioner's 3rd attempt to get the bail during the pendency of the criminal case arising from FIR No.251, dated 12.12.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sangat, District Bathinda, Punjab.

2. As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 3000 tablets of CLOVIDOL-100SR containing salt Tramadol Hydrochloride.

3. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the prosecution has only recorded deposition of three witnesses out of 13 proposed to be examined.

4. On the other hand, the learned counsel representing the State of Punjab, on instructions from ASI Som Parkash, 1453/Bathinda, submits that only one prosecution witness, namely, ASI Gurtej Singh is required to be examined and his statement will be recorded on 14.11.2023.

5. ASI Som Parkash has undertaken that ASI Gurtej Singh will remain present for recording his statement in the court on 14.11.2023.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it would not be appropriate to consider the petitioner's request for grant of bail, at this stage. However, if ASI Gurtej Singh does not appear in the court on 14.11.2023, he along with ASI Som Parkash shall be kept in prison till the statement of ASI Gurtej Singh is recorded.
7. With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
8. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
